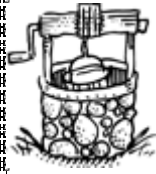

 We will take an offering and give to a relief organization, probably World Vision or Samaritan's purse.

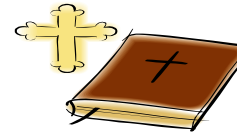
